

CD Clocks

Supplies:

Vilene or Aqua Magic washaway stabilizer to fit your hoop.

2 pieces of fabric 5 1/2" x 7"

1 piece of eazy felt, timtex or peltex) 5 1/2" x 7" (you can also use fusible fleece or quilt batting)



1. Cut your fabric & eazy felt using the instructions in the text file provided with your designs.



2. Stitch the first color in the design directly on the stabilizer. (no fabric yet)



3. Place eazy felt with fabric on top centered over outline. Tape in place at corners and put hoop on machine.



4. The 2nd color in the design tacks the fabric/felt in place.



5. Finish stitching the design by following the instructions in the text file provided with your designs.

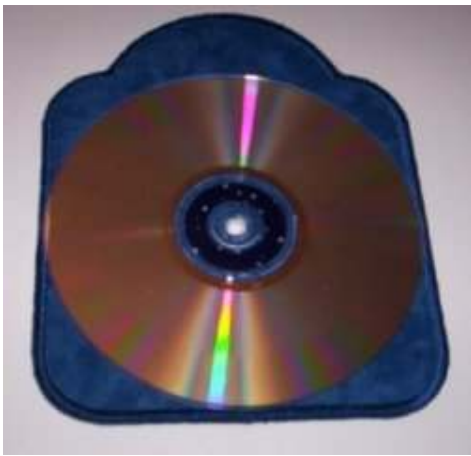


6. When instructed, remove hoop & flip over. Center 2nd piece of fabric over outline & tape in place. Put hoop back on machine.



7. The next step tacks fabric down on back of hoop. After this, remove hoop & trim excess fabric from around outline on both sides of hoop. Put hoop back on machine.

8. The last step stitches the satin outline around the edge. Remove hoop, trim design from stabilizer. Run a warm wet rag along edge to dissolve remaining wash away stabilizer.



9. Glue an old CD centered on the back of the design. Allene's tacky glue works well for this!

10. Add clock movement & place on a small easel and you are finished!
