

Checkbook/Cal Window Inserts

1. Cut the fabric, easy felt and 4 strips of wonder under transfer fusing web to the correct size.
(See text files for dimensions)



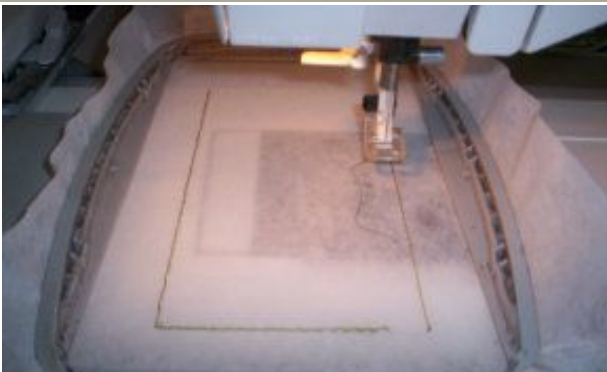
2. Iron the wonder under strips to the edges of the fabric on the wrong side.



3. Remove the paper backing from the wonder under and place the easy felt in the center of the fabric.



4. Fold the fabric edges over and press to fuse the fabric to the easy felt.



5. Hoop tear away stabilizer. Stitch first outline directly on the stabilizer, no fabric yet.



6. Center prepared fabric/felt piece inside the outline right side up. Tape at corners to secure the piece to the stabilizer.



7. Continue stitching design by following the instructions in the text files provided with your designs.

8. When finished, remove hoop & flip to back side and trim the stabilizer close to the edge of the embroidery design.



Slide the design insert inside the window on the "leather look" checkbook cover and you're finished!
