

“Pocket” Door Hangers

See the text files provided with your designs for specific supplies and fabric cutting directions.



1. Cut and prepare fabric pieces as instructed in the text files provided with your designs.



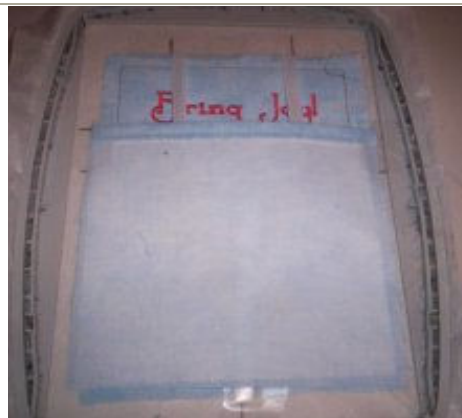
2. Hoop stabilizer. 1st color stitches outline with short placement lines on all 4 sides. Extend short placement lines to 1” long by marking directly on stabilizer so you can see them better.



3. Center prepared fabric evenly over outline. Tape at corners & put hoop on machine. Continue stitching design on front following instructions in text file.



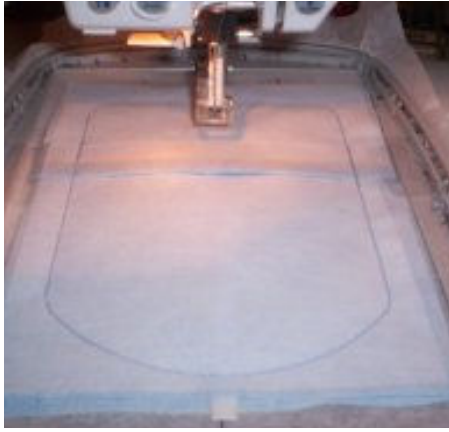
4. When instructed, add ribbon pieces to the top and bottom using the placement lines as your guide. Tape in place.



5. Center prepared pocket (wrong side up) over design keeping top of pocket even with the upper placement marks at sides. Tape in place.



6. Center back top fabric (wrong side up) over design, keeping bottom edge even with lower placement marks at sides. (wonder under at bottom) Tape in place & put hoop on machine.



7. Last color in design tacks the back fabric pieces and the ribbons in place.



8. Remove from hoop and trim excess fabric close to the outline with pinking shears. Remove Wonder Under paper backing.



9. Turn design right side out & press with press cloth over design. Add jingle bells to ribbons at the bottom.



10. Slip a 3"x 5" spiral bound note book and pen or pencil in the back pocket and hang on bedroom door!
