

Ribbon Key Fobs

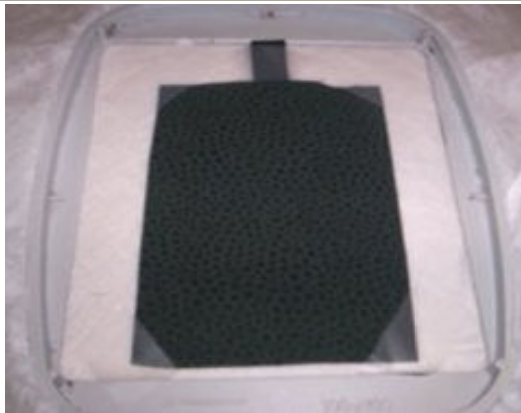
Supplies:

Vilene or Aqua Magic WASH AWAY stabilizer
Fabric (cut 1" bigger than design) Starch fabric until nice & crisp for easier trimming!
Eazy Felt (Can substitute with Timtex or Peltex – both work great as well!)
Grosgrain ribbon



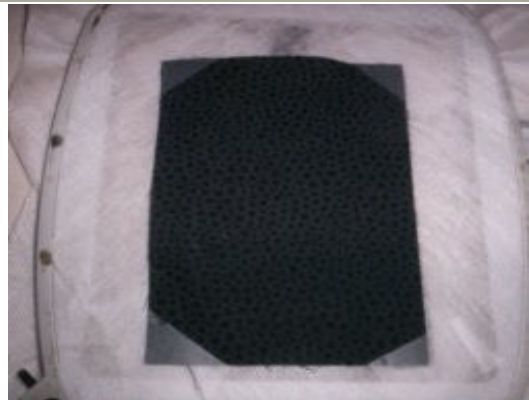
1. Hoop stabilizer in hoop. 1st outline stitched on stabilizer only. (also stitches ribbon placement lines at top).

2. Center the prepared grosgrain ribbon inside the top placement marks and tape in place.



3. Next, center easy felt inside main outline. Then center fabric evenly over outline. Tape at corners.

4. Next color stop tacks the easy felt, fabric and ribbon loop down in the hoop.



5. Continue stitching the design by following the directions in the text files provided with your designs.

6. Flip hoop over and center felt and fabric over outline. Tape in place and put hoop back on machine.



7. The next color stop tacks the fabric and felt that is under the hoop down.

8. Remove hoop. Trim felt/fabric close to outline on both side of hoop. Replace hoop on machine. (Take care to NOT cut into ribbon loop at the top!)



9. The last color stop stitches the final satin stitched edge of the key fob.

10. Trim stabilizer from around key fob. Run a warm wet rag along the edge to dissolve any remaining stabilizer.



Insert a key ring at the top and you're finished!
Optional: Add swarovsky crystals inside flower centers for extra bling bling!!
