

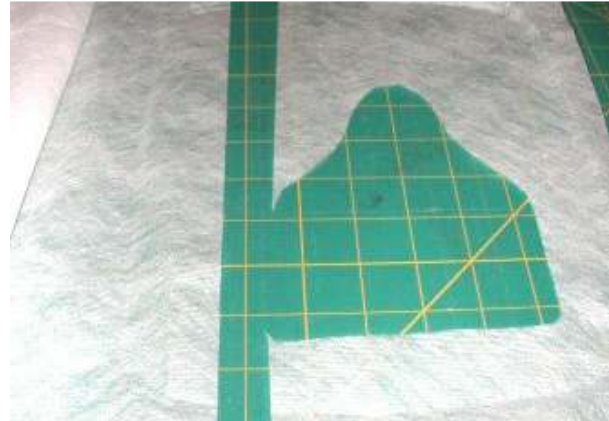
Saving Stabilizer

Most people cut one piece of stabilizer at a time to fit their hoop when stitching a design but you end up with wasted stabilizer on each side of the design each time!



Cut stabilizer to fit the "height" of your hoop and leave it the width of the stabilizer. I was using 58" wide vilene. Just folded the excess stabilizer together and pin it on the left to keep it tidy and out of the way.



After sewing my design, I just trimmed the stabilizer as shown above. This saves 2-3" of stabilizer on the left side each time to start a new design! Just unroll more stabilizer to fit your hoop and your ready to go!
